MINUTES CIMARRON MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Cimarron Municipal Utility District of Harris County, Texas (the "District"), met in regular session, open to the public, on the 15th day of November, 2023, at the regular meeting place outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

Director Jones opened the meeting for public comments. There being no member of the public present or requesting to make a public comment, Director Jones moved to the next agenda item.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the October 18, 2023, regular meeting. Following review and discussion, Director Jones moved to approve the minutes of the October 18, 2023, regular meeting, as submitted. Director Linn seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

SECURITY MATTERS

Deputy Hawn reviewed the monthly activity report from the Harris County Sheriff's Office, a copy of which is attached. He then discussed District security matters with the Board.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Mr. Watson reviewed the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached, and the Board considered payment of the bills. Following review and discussion, Director Jones moved to approve the bookkeeper's report, and payment of the bills. Director Aitken seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

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TERMINATION OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMERS

Mr. Andujar presented a list of delinquent customers and reported the residents on the termination list were delinquent in payment of their water and sewer bills and were given written notification, in accordance with the District's Rate Order, prior to the meeting of the opportunity to appear before the Board of Directors to explain, contest, or correct their bills and to show why utility services should not be terminated for reason of non-payment. Following review and discussion, Director Aitken moved to authorize termination of delinquent accounts in accordance with the District's Rate Order and direct that the delinquent customer list be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Jones seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
